



Fearless.org is the youth service of the charity **Crimestoppers**

You can use our secure online form to **report crime 100% anonymously**.

This means if you have information about something illegal, you can pass it to the police without revealing your identity. No one will know you passed on the information.

The only way anybody will know you contacted us – is if you tell somebody.
You are safe with us.

We do not need your name, address or any other personal details, we just need your information about crime.

Once you have completed the secure form, your information gets sent to our contact centre where our highly trained staff remove anything that could link it to you and then send your crime info to the police. The police then use this as intelligence. Last year, information given to us from the public helped **solve and prevent 23,500 crimes**.

IMPORTANT

- We are not an EMERGENCY service – if you need immediate help please call 999.
- If you are the victim of crime please contact the police or a victim support service (links available at the bottom of our website)

Common Questions

How can I be sure no one will know I gave this info:

- We don't ask for your name, address or any personal details.
- Your IP address is scrambled and is untraceable. This means no one can find out what info was sent and where it came from – even if they are a computer wizard.
- Any info that could be linked to you is removed before we pass your form to the police.
- Your form is not saved anywhere – it is securely deleted after being dealt with at our contact centre.

What do I need to put in the form?

When you fill in our secure form, please make sure you put in as much detail as you can. This is to make sure your information is as useful as possible.

Please think about the following:

- Full names (if known)
- Where the incident took place
 - o Try to include a full address with a post code if you can. A lot of areas often share the names of places, roads and schools.
 - DON'T: The big house on the High Street
 - DO: number 12, the high street, town, post code.
 - If you're unsure, a quick google will help you find this out.
- When the incident took place
- Details of the crime you are reporting
- Any social media handles associated with the report
- Car registration plates

Why might you use our service?

There are many reasons you may choose to give info through our service.

Here are a few examples:

- You don't want anyone to know you gave information.
- You don't want to go directly to the police.
- You don't want to get involved directly.
