# Are you looking after someone who couldn't manage without your help?

Do you look after a partner, friend or relative who needs support because of disability or a physical or mental health condition? Is this care unpaid?

If this sounds like you, then you are a carer.

Our free services include specialist support for the armed services community.

It's also important that your GP knows you are a carer. Fill in a Carers Registration Form at your GP Reception.

### **Young Carers**

If you're under 18, caring for someone and part of a serving, reservist or veteran family, you may have extra concerns, like:

- Falling behind at school because of your caring role
- Being worried about a family member on tour
- Feeling isolated, and not able to access social activities

We have specialist activities, social events and support for young people, under 18, and for 18-24s.

## **Armed Forces Carers Support**

We provide free, confidential, individual information, advice and guidance for the armed forces community. You may be still serving, a family member, a young carer, ex-services, a veteran or reservist.
