Know Your Rights

Carers have many rights. This year we want to make sure that all carers know what their rights are, and how they can access them.

Carers have the right to:

- Be identified as a carer
- determine self willingness and ability to care
- decide which needs of the person you care for you are willing and able to support
- Receive a Carer's Assessment
- Work, education, training and leisure
- Discuss flexible working options
- Be consulted on hospital discharge
- have emergency time off from work to attend to a dependent

Under *The Carer Act 2014* carers are afforded the same protection from harm in law as those they care for.
